INTERIM COVID-19 WORSHIP GUIDELINES:

- We can resume in-person worship services at 25 percent of our seating capacity.
 - Conservatively, our nave can hold about 300 people, so 25 percent of that is
 75. With worship services on Thursdays at 6:30 pm and Sundays at 9:00 am, I do not anticipate that we will exceed the 75-person limit at any one service.
- Social distancing (six-foot distance between people, except for members of the same family) will be followed as much as possible.
 - Please keep your distance as best you can from other people.
 - Some rows of pews are blocked off.
- Masks may be worn in church, but they are not required.
- Hand sanitizer will be available on stands near the trays for the used Communion cups for those who wish to use it.
- For the time being, only individual cups of Communion wine will be offered. The cups will be spaced throughout the trays to reduce the risk of touching another cup besides your own.
- Please keep some distance from others while at the Communion rail (families can remain together). Also, please remain standing so as not to touch the rail and possibly contaminate it.
- The children will not come forward for Catechism Time.
- The offering plates will be located at the back of the nave.
- The Fellowship Pads will not be completed at this time.
- Please try to follow social distancing as much as possible when leaving. We cannot congregate at the exits.
