IMPOSITION OF ASHES: At the Ash Wednesday service on **February 22**nd at **6:30 PM**, we will offer the imposition of ashes for those who wish to receive them. It is completely optional. The name "Ash Wednesday" comes from this ancient custom. The pastor dips his thumb into some ashes (traditionally made from the palm branches from the previous Palm Sunday) and marks an ashy cross on each person's forehead while saying, "Remember that you are dust, and to dust you shall return." This custom uses the biblical image of ashes (Job 42:6) to remind us that we, too, shall die and therefore need forgiveness from Jesus, which He won for us on the cross.
